



## **National Weather Service Raleigh and NC A&T Student Volunteer Program – 2022**

### **What will you do during your volunteer (unpaid) time?**

- Make 3-4 in-person visits to the Raleigh office to work alongside and visit with NWS staff in our operations area
- Multiple virtual interactions with NWS staff via Google Meet to learn about other focal points at the office
- Participate in field trips to the upper air site in Greensboro, the KRAX radar in northwest Johnston County, and possibly an ASOS
- Complete an operationally-oriented project focused on local area research
- Apply classroom learning in an operational forecast setting

### **What types of students are we looking for?**

- Students who have completed synoptic meteorology (ASME 422 at NC A&T)
- Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible

### **What does the application process involve?**

- Applicants will be required to submit a resume, transcript (official or unofficial), and a brief cover letter that describes their motivation for applying
- Applications will be examined by NWS staff, with interviews for the top applicants

### **How do I submit an application?**

- **Applications are due October 1.** Interviews will take place during October
- Applicants will be notified of their status by the end of October
- Potentially one student will be selected
- The volunteer time will occur in the spring or summer of 2022, subject to the student's availability
